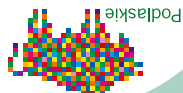

Bike Kingdom Białowieża Forest and Knyszyn Forest

The region can be described as a kingdom of the bison. Almost the entire route leads through the wilderness of the Białowieża and Knyszyn Primeval Forests. At the start, the trail takes in the capital of the Podlaskie Voivodeship – Białystok. You should take a look at the imposing Branicki Palace and gardens – known as the “Versailles of Podlasie” – and the recently renovated market square, fascinating churches and Orthodox churches, museums, and the modern Podlasie Opera and Philharmonic.



There are also several thematic trails through the city, focusing on the churches of Białystok, local wooden architecture and the Branicki family.

Next, the Green Velo route runs east to the charming village of Supraśl near the border with Belarus. It is dominated by the magnificent Orthodox Lavra Monastery, rebuilt after the Second World War and home to a unique Icon Museum.

Between the Knyszyn and Białowieża Primeval Forests, the trail runs through farmland, and there is a section opening out onto wide panoramic views. You cycle past the villages of Michałowo and Siemianówka, the Siemianówka reservoir and the village of Narewka before reaching Białowieża.

The route leads right into the heart of the Białowieża Primeval Forest along the boundary of the national park to
